RATIONALE

Laparoscopic surgery and robotic surgery have allowed the abdominal anatomy to be reviewed in light of the particular approach to the structures, thus diversifying the traditional vision obtained in open surgery. Today's surgeon must deal with a different approach to anatomy, lacking the possibility of dissecting with manual feedback, having observation angles for different regions and observing the anatomical structures magnified by the visual instrument.

Furthermore, laparoscopic surgery and more recently robotic surgery allow the surgeon to dissect by recognizing anatomical planes that are not visible in open surgery.

For these reasons, a conference dedicated to laparoscopic anatomy and not to laparoscopic techniques is very timely and useful for the training and updating of today's surgeon.

Human anatomy does not change, but the approach and dissection techniques do.
